TWO full-time Pre-K Counts classrooms will be offered at Enders-Fisherville Elementary for the 2017-2018 School Year.

The Halifax Area School District can provide your child with a FREE, high quality preschool education! Children who benefit from quality pre-kindergarten programs have a better chance of being ready for success in kindergarten, grade school, and beyond.

Enroll your child in a PA Pre-K Counts Classroom!

What can I expect from Pre-K Counts at Enders-Fisherville Elementary School?

- Less than 20 children in a classroom with a highly-qualified teacher.
- Use of curriculum approved by the PA Office of Child Development and Early Learning to meet Early Learning Standards.
- Regular reviews of each child’s progress and a range of learning activities differentiated for children’s interests and needs.
- Support and transition to kindergarten.
- Academic and social-emotional growth.
- A FREE program, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

**The portion of the day that is funded through PA Pre-K Counts is free to qualified families. If your child requires additional care, before or after the funded portion of the school day, you may be eligible to use Child Care Information Services (CCIS) or another funding source to cover your payments.*

Available slots will be filled based on multiple need factors from students registered during the enrollment window. Other eligible students will be placed on a waiting list.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR PRE-K COUNTS?

- Children age 3 until the entry age for Kindergarten (preference will be given to 4 year olds);
- Halifax families earning up to 300% of the federal poverty level (or a family of four earning \$72,900 or less) are eligible to apply!

How much does Pre-K Counts cost?

Pre-K Counts is free to qualifying families.*

How can I enroll my child?

The first enrollment window is open until March 16, 2017.
